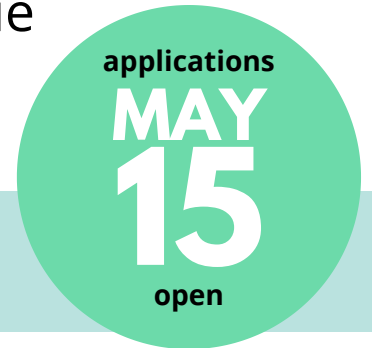




CANADA EMERGENCY STUDENT BENEFIT

Providing financial support for students who are unable to find work due to COVID-19



AVAILABLE MAY - AUG 2020

\$1,250 for each 4 week period

OR

If you have dependents or a disability

\$2,000 for each 4 week period

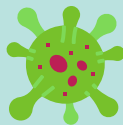
..... you will need to apply every 4 weeks if your situation continues

ELIGIBILITY

The benefit is being offered to all students, new graduates, Canadians studying abroad and high school students who are set to enter post-secondary in the fall.



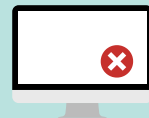
you are a Canadian Citizen



you are unable to work due to COVID-19 or are working earning less than \$1,000 during the 4 week period you are applying for



you did not apply, receive, nor qualify for the CERB or EI benefits for the same eligibility period



you are a post-secondary or recent post-secondary student or a recent high school graduate

the benefit is taxable in the 2020 tax year
